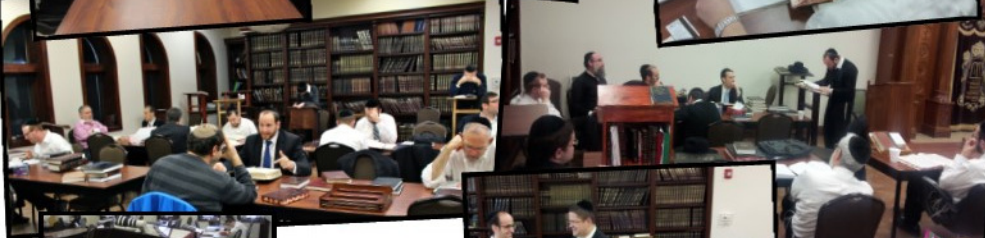


## Nightly Beis Medrash

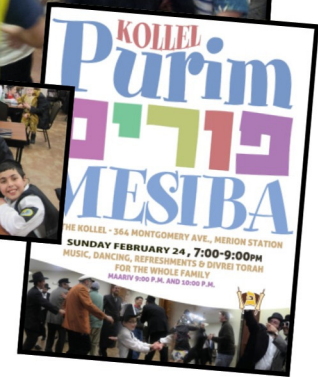


**Ramban on Chumash**

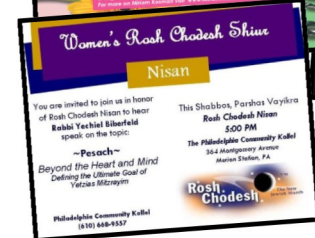
