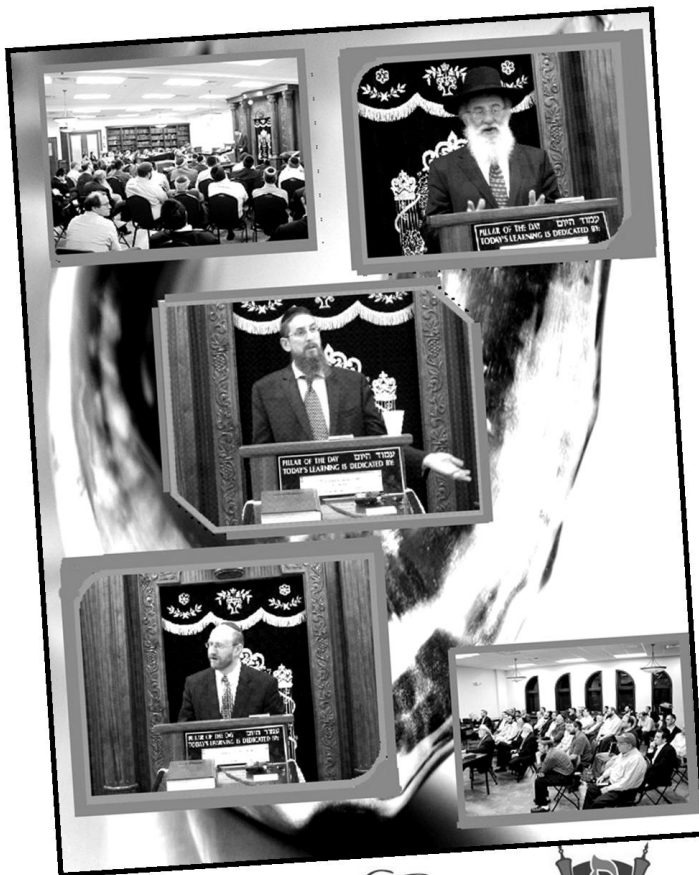
College Boys Program

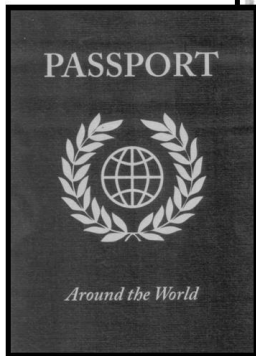

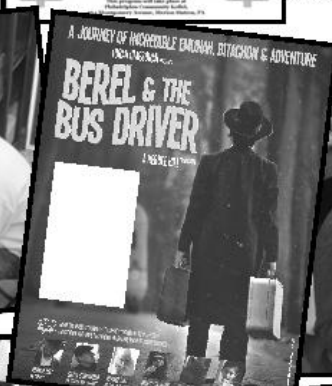
